SAMUEL ANNOINTED SAUL

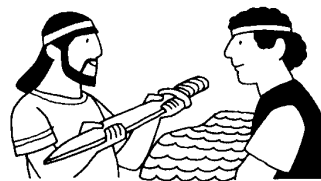
Saul disobeyed God; God rejected Saul as king.

DAVID AND JONATHAN

Saul, out of his jealousy, tried to kill David.



DAVID AND SAUL

Saul and his sons were killed by the Philistines and David became king over all Israel.

David sinned with Bathsheba, but repented and was restored by God.



DAVID AND BATHSHEBA

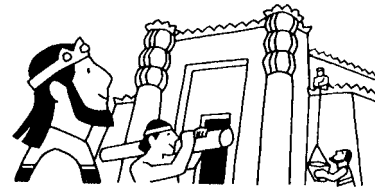
Solomon, David's son, became king and asked God for wisdom to rule the kingdom.

QUEEN OF SHEBA

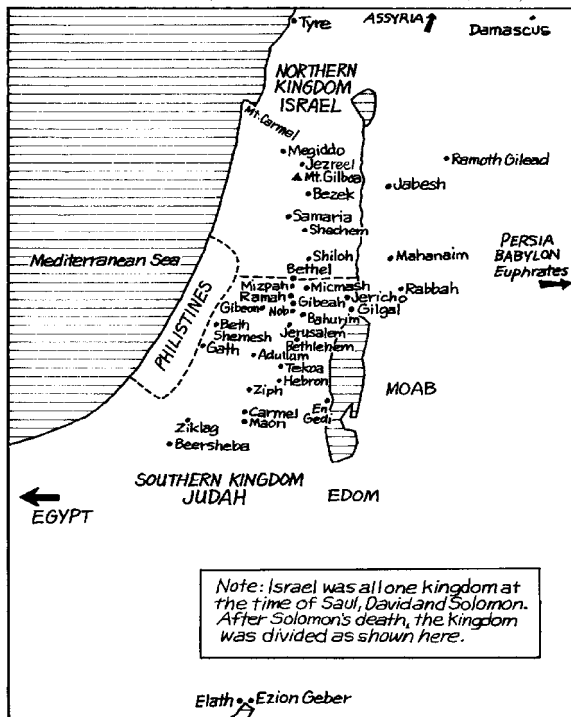


Solomon built a temple for the worship of God.

TEMPLE

Solomon had many wives then followed after idols in his later years. God divided Solomon's kingdom in two parts after his death.
